

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Policy



Echo Marine Group is a multidisciplined shipbuilder, specialising in new build and sustainment of vessels for Luxury, Commercial and Defence customers.

Requirement

Visitors are required to sign a visitor register when entering and exiting the facility.

Objectives

For the safety and security of all Staff, Visitors and Contractors please note the following Conditions of Entry in relation to entry to the Echo Marine Group (EMG) facility.

- Management reserves the right to manage access and departure to and from the site via screening equipment/checks.
- All must comply with any request for vehicle and personal bag searching.
- Management reserves the right to inspect, on arrival and departure any bag, vehicle and/or articles of clothing for the following prohibited items:
 - Alcohol (unless authorised by Management)
 - Illegal substances including controlled, dangerous or illicit drugs
 - Any other item that could cause harm or public nuisance
- The facility is a smoke-free facility – smoking (including the use of e-cigarettes) is not permitted.
- To enhance the safety of persons at the facility and ensure compliance with conditions of entry, EMG uses surveillance equipment within and surrounding the Facility, including security cameras. By entering the facility, you consent to information about yourself (including images) being recorded by such surveillance equipment. You further agree to Management disclosing the information recorded to anyone (including law enforcement bodies) involved in relevant legal or disciplinary actions.
- By entering the facility, all consent to their image, likeness or voice being captured and used as part of any recording of an event or for any other purposes.
- You may be refused access to or be removed from the facility if you:
 - enter the Facility without the relevant authorisation
 - are deemed by Management to be displaying disorderly, offensive or unlawful behaviour
 - use foul or abusive language, or make racial or threatening remarks or gestures; or
 - fail to comply with any of these Conditions of Entry or requests from the facility staff or their representatives, or
 - any attempt to remove objects from site, not belonging to yourself, without the necessary approval, will be reported to the Authorities
